The Andalusian Association for the Defense of Children and Prevention of Child Mistreatment (ADIMA) has been developing, since its formation in 1990, multiple actions directed to the prevention and attention to different forms of child mistreatment, as well as the promotion of social volunteer work specialized in acting with minors that are in situations of psychosocial risk.

During the month of November of this year, the X National Conference of the Federation of Associations for the Prevention of Child Mistreatment (FAPMI), is celebrated in Seville, organized on this occasion by the Andalusian Association for the Defense of Children and Prevention of Child Mistreatment (ADIMA), whose slogan is "Building of Wellbeing and Good Practices in the Attention to Children".

Since the formation of the Organizing Committee for the elaboration of the preliminary design of the program of the mentioned Conference, it was approved to include within the following list of activities of the Conference, the initiative that is presented here.



Bearing in mind that the formative character is the same, it was equally decided that the celebration proposal should be given to the authority of the Faculty of Psychology of the Hispalense University, collaborating entity of the Conference as well as in this activity.

General Objective

To establish a formative meeting on the subject of child-youth mistreatment in diverse typological demonstrations, through the celebration of a participative Cinema-Forum that will include a viewing of a film previously selected for this reason. After seeing the film, the different participant experts will expose contents relative to the subject matter presented in the film.

Specific Objectives

Articulate answers for the attention of mistreated children.

Develop a specific formative activity by professionals specialized in this matter.

Promote the participation of professionals and interested university students.

Spread the mentioned objectives through the cinematographic arts to generate a cultural and ludic space of help and contrast about the contents that need treated.
